

Criterion for Grade

1. Demonstration of intended use

- (a) Discuss and defend all of the tasks you have the user do (why do you have the user do something?)
- (b) Discussion of expected time to complete room (Hint: if it takes more than 4 minutes... it's too long!)
- (c) Discussion of visual cues that tell the user what to do
- (d) Discussion of exceptional circumstances and how your program avoids them (like what bad things the user could do they you avoid - like leaving the room before completing all the tasks, etc)

2. Explanation of Program Design

- (a) Discuss how you organized your code
  - (i) What was good about it?
  - (ii) What would you do differently in the future?
  - (iii) Does it allow you to add new features easily in the future?
- (b) Discuss how you implemented cool features (fading effect, animation, etc)

3. Miscellaneous

- (a) Your presentation should be no longer than 7 minutes
- (b) You should speak loud enough that the whole class can hear
- (c) You do NOT need to make a powerpoint
